Please Note

The nation-wide response to COVID-19 (Coronavirus) continues to develop and is changing rapidly.

The information below relates to adult sports only.

Changes to Adult Sports

We have been given permission to change some aspects of our operations to ensure we comply with government requirements. QPRC Indoor Sports is taking a cautious approach for the safety of staff and patrons.

We ask that you read this information carefully as it has important details regarding the temporary restrictions and processes we will be operating under.

Cleaning Requirements

In order to offer adult sports competitions, we need to do extensive cleaning between each game or user group. Therefore we require a 30 minute break between games so that:

- all participants can leave the facility prior to the next group of participants entering
- all high touch points, chairs, family change room/disabled toilet are cleaned.

Arrival

Please arrive no earlier than 10 minutes before your game. We will be unable to let you into the venue until all the cleaning requirements are complete. After your first game, you will get an idea on how long the process will take for future planning.

Please limit questions/discussion during the check-in process to limit queues. We are happy to answer any of your queries and take payments outside of your game time, although payment upfront or prior to the game over the phone is the preferred option.

Spectators

In general, spectators are not encouraged to limit the number of people within the venue.

Leaving

Please leave within 10 minutes of your game. This will assist us to complete all the cleaning requirements to ensure that the following games start on time.

Game Times

Adult Sports will commence from Tuesday 22 September.

Due to the additional cleaning, we will be required to cap team numbers. Brief details are listed below:

Sport	Day	Game Length	Maximum Team Numbers	Timeslots
Netball	Tuesdays	4 x 10 minute quarters (50 minute timeslots)	12	6:30pm and 7:50pm
Futsal	Wednesdays	2 x 17 minute halves (40 minute timeslots)	18	6:30pm, 7:40pm and 8:50pm
Floorball	Thursdays	3 x 17 minute periods (60 minute timeslots)	4	6:30pm and 8:00pm

The season will be 13 weeks in length and conclude by Thursday 17 December.

Social Distancing

Social distancing whilst playing is difficult. Please note that under the current Public Health Order, social distancing is currently not required for community sport. Social distancing outside the playing court and maximum patron numbers do apply.

Equipment

You are encouraged to bring your own equipment. Game equipment such as bibs and netballs will be used once per day and cleaned prior to the next use.

Match Information

To prevent sharing of pens and touching the same paper, different procedures will apply. The referee will ask to confirm the score verbally rather than getting a signature. Individuals will not be required to sign on. Team captains will be required to log information online or email staff or participants for each game.

Illness

The safety of our patrons and staff is of utmost importance, we ask that you do the right thing and stay at home if you are unwell.

Staff Illness

If a staff member is sick, they will be required to take sick leave. Therefore your game may be cancelled with limited notice if we are unable to find a healthy replacement. For example, they may fail a temperature check upon entry. We will do our best to contact you via your registered email if your game is cancelled. We will look to alter fees if your game is unable to be replayed due to this reason.

Further Communication

We wish to provide a safe environment for patrons as well as staff.

Finally, the situation is changing and we will advise if further changes occur as soon as practical.
